Located at the top of the hills above the village of Curtil-Vergy, alongside the woods of the old abbey of Romanée Saint Vivant.

Planted with tall vines, the terroir enjoys good sunshine and produces grapes that are always nicely ripe and concentrated.

A generous nose of red fruits with notes of blackcurrant bud.

An elegant, round and fruity palate with aromas of blackcurrant and cherry. Nice tannins, supple and well-integrated.

Serve at : 14°-15°C

Grape : Pinot Noir

Surface : 3 ha

Soil : Clay-limestone

Age of vines : 1985

Exposure : West, South-West

Location : Top of the slope

Harvest : Hand-picked with sorting at the vineyard then on a vibrating sorting table. 100% scuffed.

Winemaking : Vatting 15 to 18 days cold pre-fermentation maceration then 5 to 6 days alcoholic fermentation with periodic punching down and pumping over.
