

# MENETOU-SALON NICOLAS GIRARD 2019



**Appellation :**  
AOP Menetou-Salon

13,5% ALC/VOL

**Variety :**

100% Sauvignon Blanc

**Terroir :**

A sunny, southwest facing terroir in the commune of Morogues where the Kimmeridgian marl bedrock lies just 50 centimeters below the soil. The temperatures here are usually cool, yet sunny and lend to this wines full body and richness.

**Vinification :**

Grapes are pressed directly upon arrival at the winery. The juice is then fermented and aged on in lees in stainless steel tanks.

**Tasting Notes :**

This wine has a pale straw yellow appearance, it has a vibrant and aromatic nose, with white fruit, pepper and mineral notes. Medium-bodied and round palate, with hints of menthol coupled with an elegant acidity.

**Food Pairings:**

Sauvignon blanc pairs well with grilled seafood, salads or enjoyed on it's own. Serve chilled.
