### Terroir & Vinification Village of Cesseras

This village is located on the northwest part of Carcassonne and the Languedoc. Right at the edge in between the Atlantic climate influence and Mediterranean climate, which allow the grapes to keep some great acidity and have the great ripeness of the south. So all white grapes and cool climate reds like Pinot Noir show very well.

The northwest hills of this area are covered with a combination of light and stony argilo-calcareous soils.

### Tasting notes

Juicy black cherry and wild raspberry notes have pleasant underbrush, spice and licorice, all bound together by citrusy acidity. Moderate, plush tannins offer good support through the mineral-lined finish
