

TASTING NOTES:

Visual stage: Pale yellow with green reflections, clear and brilliant.

Olfactory stages: Intense, full nose with a marked varietal character. Aromas reminiscent of plants that blend perfectly with fruity notes, with tones of citrus fruits and pit fruits standing out, as well as hints of lemon verbena and mint.

Tasting stages: Moderate acidity on the palate, fresh while at the same time maintaining its aromatic complexity. In short, an Albariño wine with character.

Clear and brilliant, pale yellow in colour with green reflections. Intense, pronounced, complex herbal notes (lemon verbena, fennel, bay, mint) and hints of fruits (passion fruits, apricot, grapefruit). Well-structured, it maintains the aromatic complexity of the nose and is long and fresh in the finish.
