## **TASTING NOTES**

Deep, bright ruby red. Highly complex, aromatic nose, with spicy aromas of black pepper, cinnamon and vanilla underscored by hints of game on a background of very ripe fruit, all of wich are perfectly blended. Meaty, ample and long in the mouth, with an aftertaste full of spicy aromas that confer great elegance and personality.



Vilano is a cooperative founded in 1957, in Pedrosa del Duero, and has access to some 741 acres of vineyards, most of them very old. This Reserva comes from vines planted more than 50 years ago at an altitude of 2,642 feet. Instead of being ample and grand, like many of the region's wines, this is vertical and pungent, focused on bright red fruit, highlighted by notes of gooseberry and herbs. It feels electric and tight, with a lovely spicy finish—a new direction in Ribera del Duero.
